First off, thank you from all of us at M&S for giving us a great year! We have a great studio family and we were very blessed with such supporting families! We can't wait to watch your dancer and all of our dancers shine on the stage for this seasons recital!

Let's Make History!

Here is the guide to EVERYTHING recital! Recital is such an important element in finishing our season at Mind & Sole it allows:

> -Your dancer to show all of their progress through out the year -Gives your dancer a chance to perform. -Helps your dancer gain confidence for years to come.

Mandatory Dress Rehearsals:

<u>Please come in your M&S recital outfit for dress rehearsal, you do not have to have hair and make up done for dress rehearsal but we want to have costumes and outfits worn.</u>

Thursday June 6th: Show I Dress Rehearsal 4:30-7:00

Friday June 7th: Show 2 Dress Rehearsal 4:30-7:00

(Why do dress rehearsals? This allows your dancer to understand how recital will work to create a smooth run of the show. It also gets them used to the stage and lets them practice their dances in a different area.)

We are hoping each show to only be about an hour and 30 minutes long so the dress rehearsals could end earlier than scheduled time. During dress rehearsals we ask that if your dancer is 8 & under a parent be present in case we end earlier.

<u>RECITAL Day!</u>

Saturday Recital Day June 8th:

Show 1- Arrive 9:15, Doors Open 9:30 Show Starts 10:00am

Show 2- Arrive 12:15, Doors Open 12:30, Show Starts 1:00pm

Show 3 Arrive 3:15, Doors Open 3:30, Show Starts 4:00

Dancer Etiquette:

-Please pick up after yourself and don't leave a mess.
-No running in the halls
-Please have dancers backstage 3 numbers before their dance.
-NO FOOD in Theater
-When not dancing all dancers need to be in the balcony watching with helping mothers.

Helping Parents (Tiny Tot, Level 1 & Level 2 Parents):

-Sign Up for Helping Moms starts May 1

-We will have a roster list for each class given to you.

-Please have your dancers backstage three numbers before they go.

-Please have dancers in the balcony to watch when not performing.

-We appreciate any help we can get and this helps our shows move smooth and fast, if you sign up for a helping parent you will not need a ticket and will have a badge to wear for that day.

Costumes/Makeup/Hair:

-Have your dancer fully ready and dressed before arrival on recital day. Due to limited dressing room space the Competition Team dancers will be the only one allowed to use the backstage dressing rooms. All recreational dancers have one outfit and when they arrive need to be fully ready to dress rehearsal and recital day they will go straight to the balcony for announcements and start of show.

Make Up:

Have your dancer wear enough make up for the stage:

~foundation

~blush

~natural eyeshadow and mascara with a little bit of eyeliner

~pink lips

-eyelashes (Optional unless on team)

Hair:

Tiny Tots: Whatever you would like as long as it is out of face with head piece.

Level 1-5: Middle part with a slicked low pony with sparkle head piece on right side. (These will be passed out during picture week to recreational students, if you are on team you just need the silver barrettes you have for team hair)

-Competition Team Kids (Normal Team Hair & MakeUp for recital day)

Video:

NO Videos will be a loud during the recital!! It is distracting to our dancers. We will be having a videographer at the recital and a recital dvd will be available, forms will be sent out soon!

Scholarship Recital T-Shirt:

Scholarship T-Shirts will be \$20.00 this year and all money made from shirts will go towards our M&S Scholarship Fund where we are able to award select dancers with scholarships for the upcoming summer or seasons! May 10th

Ticket Sales:

We will be passing out a ticket reserve form at the beginning of May, each family will be allotted 5 tickets per family for each show, once those are turned in we will have a ticket sale day for the leftover tickets! Ticket Forms will be Due May 17th. Form attached

Important Notes/Dates Review:

All Dancer Accounts need to have a \$0.00 balance before the recital date. (This includes all team fees, recital fees, costume fees and tuition.) If you do not have a 0.00 balance your child will not be able to participate in this years recital.
